- Assists in all aspects of construction administration including shop drawing reviews, responding to RFI's, etc.
- Assists in the tendering process and drawing distribution for contractors
- Review contract documentation

- Conducts site walkthroughs where appropriate
- Prepares supplementary instructions as required
- Prepares and creates Addenda as required
